NOTICE OF CONTESTED CASE

Issue Date: June 24, 2010Effective Date: June 24, 2010The Missouri Public Service Commission is giving notice of the institution of a

contested case.

On December 10, 2009, the Commission suspended the tariffs that Laclede Gas Company filed on October 30, 2009, which the statutes allow only pending a "full" hearing and decision on the tariff's propriety. ¹ The provision for a full pre-decision hearing signifies that this action is a "contested case." ² A contested case is a formal hearing procedure, but it allows for waiver of procedural formalities³ and a decision without a hearing,⁴ including by stipulation and agreement.⁵

This notice does not require any party to file an answer. The Commission's discovery regulations are at 4 CSR 240-2.090. Because the "hearing involv[es] a rate sought to be increased, the burden of proof to show that the . . . proposed increased rate is just and reasonable shall be upon the gas corporation seeking the increase[.⁶]"
