STAFF'S PARTIAL RESPONSE TO PRAXAIR, INC.'S AND EXPLORER PIPELINE COMPANY'S APPLICATION FOR REHEARING, RECONSIDERATION OR MODIFICATION OF SUSPENSION ORDER, AND STAFF'S RESPONSE TO PRAXAIR'S AND EXPLORER PIPELINE'S <u>PROVISIONAL APPLICATION TO INTERVENE</u>

Comes now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) in partial response to Praxair Inc.'s (Praxair) and Explorer Pipeline Company's (Explorer Pipeline) Application For Rehearing, Reconsideration Or Modification Of Suspension Order filed on February 17, 2006, and in response to Praxair's And Explorer Pipeline's Provisional Application To Intervene filed on February 24, 2006.¹ Praxair and Explorer Pipeline have correctly related the provision on page 10, in section III.D.1.c. "Intervention In Rate Cases," in the Stipulation And Agreement filed on July 18, 2005 by the Signatory Parties thereto and approved on August 2, 2005 by the Commission in Case No. EO-2005-0263 (*In the Matter of The Empire District Electric Company's Application for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Approval of an Experimental Regulatory Plan Related to Generation Plant*).

The Staff respectfully requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) recognize the terms of the Stipulation And Agreement that it approved in Case No. EO-2005-0263 and grant intervenor status to not only Praxair and Explorer Pipeline, but also to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR), which is the only other signatory

party to the Stipulation And Agreement in Case No. EO-2005-0263, other than the Office of the Public Counsel and the Staff. Praxair and Explorer Pipeline are represented by Mr. Stuart W. Conrad (MBE# 23966), 3100 Broadway, Suite1209, Kansas City, MO 64111. MDNR is represented by Ms. Shelley A. Woods (MBE# 33525), Missouri Attorney General's Office, P.O. Box 899, Jefferson City, MO 65102.

Wherefore the Staff requests that the Commission grant intervenor status to Praxair Inc., Explorer Pipeline Company and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation And Agreement approved by the Commission on August 2, 2005 in Case No. EO-2005-0263.
