**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE**

On July 3, 2006, Aquila, Inc., submitted proposed tariff sheets designed to implement a general rate increase for retail electric service provided by Aquila to customers in its Aquila Networks – MPS and Aquila Networks – L&P service areas. The Commission issued notice of that filing on July 5, and established July 25 as the deadline for submission of requests to intervene. The City of St. Joseph, Missouri, filed an application to intervene on July 11. AG Processing Inc., a Cooperative, and the Sedalia Industrial Energy Users' Association filed separate applications to intervene on July 14. More than ten days have passed since these applications to intervene were filed and no party has objected to them.

The Commission finds that each of these applicants has an interest that is different than that of the general public and that its interest may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing these applicants to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The City of St. Joseph, Missouri's Application to Intervene is granted.
2. The Sedalia Industrial Energy Users' Association's Application to Intervene is granted.
3. AG Processing Inc., a Cooperative's Application to Intervene is granted.
4. This order shall become effective on July 26, 2006.
