ORDER ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On February 25, 2014, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Laclede Gas Company (MGE), the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and Midwest Gas Users' Association jointly filed a proposed procedural schedule that has been agreed upon by all parties. The Commission will adopt the proposed procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following procedural schedule is established:

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| MGE Testimony | - | March 5, 2014 |
| List of Issues, List of Witnesses, Order of Cross and Order of Opening Statements | - | March 7, 2014 |
| Statements of Position | - | March 10, 2014 |
| Hearing | - | March 11, 2014, beginning at 8:30 a.m. |
| Post-Hearing Briefs | - | March 17, 2014 |
| Statutory Deadline | - | April 5, 2014 |

2. The parties shall comply with the following procedural requirements:

- (A) The parties shall agree upon and Staff shall file a list of the issues to be heard, the witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing, the order in

which they will be called, and the order of cross-examination for each witness. The list of issues should be detailed enough to inform the Commission of each issue that must be resolved. The Commission will view any issue not contained in this list of issues as uncontested and not requiring resolution by the Commission.

(B) Each party shall file a simple and concise statement summarizing its position on each disputed issue.

(C) All pleadings, briefs, and amendments shall be filed in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080. Briefs shall follow the same list of issues as filed in the case and must set forth and cite the proper portions of the record concerning the remaining unresolved issues that are to be decided by the Commission.

(D) All parties shall bring enough copies of exhibits that they intend to offer into evidence at the hearing. If an exhibit has not been prefiled, the party offering it must bring, in addition to the copy for the court reporter, a copy for each Commissioner, the Presiding Judge, and all counsel.

3. The hearing shall be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
