ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF THE MISSOURI INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS

On April 4, 2008, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed a tariff designed to increase its annual revenues for electric service. The Commission suspended that tariff and established April 28 as the deadline for interested parties to apply to intervene.

The Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC), applied to intervene on April 18.

MIEC is a group of large industrial customers. More than ten days have passed since MIEC applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that the interest of MIEC in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing MIEC to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.
