## ORDER REGARDING TRUE-UP HEARING

Issue Date: December 31, 2008 Effective Date: December 31, 2008

A hearing regarding true-up issues is scheduled for January 6 and 7, 2009. In compliance with the previously established procedural schedule, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE filed the true-up direct testimony of Gary Weiss on December 22, 2008. On that same date, the Commission's Staff filed a statement indicating that it is not aware of any issues that the Commission would need to consider at a true-up hearing. No other party filed true-up direct testimony and no party filed true-up rebuttal testimony by the December 30 deadline established in the procedural schedule.

If no party requests a true-up hearing or objects to the admission of Weiss' true-up testimony, the Commission will cancel that hearing and admit the true-up testimony into evidence. So that the parties and the Commission will know as soon as possible whether a hearing will be required, the Commission will establish Noon on January 2 as the deadline for the filing of either a request for a true-up hearing or objections to admission of the true-up testimony.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to request a true-up hearing shall do so no later than Noon on January 2, 2009.

- 2. Any party wishing to object to the admission of the True-Up Direct Testimony of Gary S. Weiss shall submit its written objection no later than Noon on January 2, 2009.
  - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
