**ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS TO EXTEND FILING DATES**

Issue Date: December 11, 2009

Effective Date: December 11, 2009

On December 9, 2009, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion to extend the filing deadline for prefiled testimony regarding non-transportation issues. Staff represents that certain parties have reached an agreement in principle as to all issues except the transportation issues.<sup>1</sup> These parties would like to use their resources to finalize a Stipulation and Agreement as to Non-Transportation Issues rather than turn their attention to filing rebuttal testimony regarding non-transportation issues which most likely will become unnecessary. Accordingly, these parties request that the Commission extend the filing dates for rebuttal and surrebuttal testimony on non-transportation issues to December 18 and 29, 2009, respectively. Rebuttal testimony regarding transportation issues was filed on December 9, 2009.

Constellation NewEnergy-Gas Division, LLC, filed a motion seeking to extend the filing date for the transportation issues surrebuttal testimony to December 29, 2009. Constellation's counsel states that he has contacted counsel for all the parties and none

objects to this request. Both Staff and Constellation allege that no other change in the existing procedural schedule will be necessary as a result of these extensions.

Having considered Staff's and Constellation's motions, the Commission finds it reasonable to extend the filing dates for testimony on non-transportation and transportation issues as set out below.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Staff's Motion to Extend Date for Filing of Pre-Filed Testimony is granted.
2. Constellation NewEnergy-Gas Division, LLC's Motion to Extend Date for Filing of Pre-Filed Surrebuttal Testimony on Transportation Issues is granted.
3. All parties' prefiled rebuttal testimony on non-transportation issues, or a written stipulation and agreement regarding those issues, shall be filed no later than December 18, 2009.
4. All parties' prefiled surrebuttal testimony on non-transportation issues shall be filed no later than December 29, 2009, unless a stipulation and agreement resolving those issues has previously been filed.
5. All parties' prefiled surrebuttal testimony on transportation issues shall be filed no later than December 29, 2009.
6. After the filing of non-transportation rebuttal testimony, the response time for non-transportation-related data requests shall be five business days to provide the requested information, and three business days to object or to notify the requesting party that more than five business days will be needed to provide the requested information.

7. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
