The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Motion to Continue Low Income Program Pending Approval of Stipulation and Agreement* ("motion").

Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede") filed the motion on July 28, 2010, seeking an order continuing the operation of Laclede's Low-Income Energy Assistance Program ("program"). The program arises from an earlier action¹ in which the Commission's order² incorporated the parties' settlement.³ In the motion, Laclede states that such order terminates the program on July 29, 2010.

To avoid interruption of service to low-income persons, Laclede asks the Commission to continue the program pending resolution of this action. Laclede represents that it filed the motion on behalf of the Program Review and Evaluation Team. On those representations, the Commission will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion to Continue Low Income Program Pending Approval of Stipulation and Agreement is granted.
