## CORRECTION ORDER

Due to an oversight the Commission's order issued August 31, 1989, in the above-referenced cases omitted the language set forth below.

On page 3 the following paragraph should be inserted after the first full paragraph:

Since the Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) audit associated with this tariff has not been completed by Staff, the Commission determines that the portion of this tariff which is the subject of the audit should be declared interim subject to refund. Also on page 3 the first sentence of the last paragraph preceding the ordered sections should be corrected as follows:

"...the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed tariff sheet should be allowed to become effective on and after the requested effective date of September 1, 1989, on an interim basis subject to refund as to the TOP and ACA elements contained therein."

Ordered: 1 on page 3 should be corrected to read as follows:

"...is allowed hereby to become effective for service on and after September 1, 1989, on an interim basis subject to refund as to the Take-or-Pay and Actual Cost Adjustment elements contained therein..."

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the order issued on August 31, 1989, in the above-referenced cases is corrected hereby as set forth herein.

ORDERED: 2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
