Page 4 1 (The following proceedings began at 12:10 p.m.:) 2 JUDGE HATCHER: Let's go on the record. First I want to ask that everyone please mute themselves 3 unless speaking. That will cut down on the noise level 4 and prevent audio feedback. 5 Today is August 9, 2022. The Missouri Public 6 7 Service Commission has set this time for a local public 8 hearing to give members of the public a chance to comment about Evergy Missouri West's electric general 9 10 rate increase application. That is File No. 11 ER-2022-0130. And I would like to state for the record 12 Chairman Ryan Silvey has joined us. 13 CHAIRMAN SILVEY: Good morning, Judge. 14 15 JUDGE HATCHER: Good afternoon, Chairman. The Missouri Public Service Commission 16 17 regulates the rates charged by public utility companies 18 in Missouri to ensure that those rates are just and 19 reasonable. The Commission also regulates the quality 20 of service and safety of the operations of public 21 utilities. 22 The Commission is made up of five 23 Commissioners. The Commissioners are appointed by the Governor to fixed terms and confirmed by the Senate. 24 25 The Commissioners employ a staff of engineers,

Page 5 accountants, attorneys, financial analysts, and other 1 2 specialists in the field of utility regulation. My name is Charles Hatcher, and I'm the 3 Regulatory Law Judge that will preside over this 4 5 hearing. With me today are Chairman Ryan Silvey and Commissioners Maida Coleman, Jason Holsman, and Glen 6 7 Kolkmeyer. This is an official hearing of the Missouri 8 9 Public Service Commission, and the statements and 10 testimony of the witnesses will be recorded by a court reporter and are given under oath. 11 12 The Commission has not made any decision in 13 this case and therefore the Commissioners cannot answer any questions today. They have to remain impartial 14 15 until all of the evidence is presented. Let's go ahead and start with an entry of 16 17 appearance. We'll start with the Company, Everyy Missouri West. Go ahead. 18 19 MR. FISCHER: On behalf of the Company, we 20 have Roger Steiner and James Fischer. 21 JUDGE HATCHER: Thank you, sir. And for the Staff of the Commission. 2.2 23 MS. MERS: For the Staff of the Missouri 24 Public Service Commission, Nicole Mers, and my 25 information has been previously provided in the docket.

Page 6 1 Thank you all for being here. 2 JUDGE HATCHER: Thank you, Ms. Mers. And for the Office of the Public Counsel. 3 MR. CLIZER: Good afternoon. John Clizer on 4 behalf of the Missouri Office of the Public Counsel. 5 Thank you, Mr. Clizer. 6 JUDGE HATCHER: 7 We also have a number of intervenors in the 8 case. As I did yesterday, they are not required to be here, but I do want to offer any of their counsel the 9 10 opportunity to state for the record their attendance. 11 Hearing none. 12 A quick explanation. The process for this hearing is going to be to call the names on our 13 pre-registered sign-up sheet. That was the email the 14 15 Commission asked everyone to send in before they testified. 16 17 Today we do have a list of three witnesses. 18 I'm going to call those names in the order that they 19 signed up, and then I will open the floor up to anyone who is on our call today who would like to testify and 20 21 did not sign up first. 22 With that said, one guick reminder. If you 23 have phoned in, in order to unmute you press \*6. 24 Okay. Let's get started. Our first name is 25 Gerald Maloney. Gerald Maloney. If you would please
