ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On June 12, 2006, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a recommendation regarding tariff sheets filed by Aquila, Inc. In its Certificate of Service, Staff Counsel states that he has served the pleading on “all counsel of record.” Because the official case file was only opened with the filing of Staff’s pleading, it is unclear if the company and the Office of the Public Counsel were served.

Public Counsel also filed a motion on June 12, 2006. Public Counsel indicates in its Certificate of Service that it has served its motion on the General Counsel of the Public Service Commission, but there is no indication that the motion was served on Aquila. The Commission will direct its Staff and the Public Counsel to each file a notice indicating whether they have served their pleadings on the company. Staff shall also indicate whether it served its pleading on the Public Counsel.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel shall each file a notice as set out above no later than June 16, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on June 13, 2006.
