ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

Issue Date: September 14, 2006 Effective Date: September 16, 2006

On August 17, 2006, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE filed a tariff revision that makes certain changes to its Missouri Change-a-Light Program. The tariff carries an effective date of September 16.

The Commission's Staff filed its recommendation regarding AmerenUE's tariff changes on September 11. Staff explains that AmerenUE initially agreed to fund the Change-a-Light Program as a part of the stipulation and agreement that resolved Case No. EC-2002-1. The changes to the program that AmerenUE has included in the pending tariff will extend the program for another year. Staff indicates that the tariff changes comply with the previously approved stipulation and agreement. Staff recommends that the Commission either approve the tariff to become effective on September 16, or allow it to go into effect by operation of law. No other party has filed a recommendation regarding the tariff.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission determines that the tariff complies with the previously approved stipulation and agreement. The tariff will be approved effective September 16.
