## **ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATIONS**

Effective Date: August 1, 2007

In its Report and Order in AmerenUE's recent rate case, ER-2007-0002, the Commission ordered Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE to file a revised Industrial Demand Response tariff. AmerenUE complied with the Commission's order by filing its revised tariff on July 2, 2007. Recognizing that interested parties would need to engage in further discussions and negotiations before the tariff could be put in final form, AmerenUE gave the tariff a 90-day effective date of October 1. Subsequently, the Commission allowed Noranda Aluminum, Inc.; the Missouri Energy Group (MEG); and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) to intervene.

The Commission expects the parties to continue informal discussions and negotiations on their own to try to reach agreement concerning the appropriate content of AmerenUE's Industrial Demand Response tariff. However, to ensure that the Commission has time to fully consider the tariff before its effective date, the Commission will order its Staff to file a recommendation regarding AmerenUE's tariff no later than August 31. Other interested parties will be allowed until September 10 to respond to Staff's recommendation, or to file a recommendation of their own.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Commission's Staff shall file its recommendation regarding AmerenUE's Industrial Demand Response Program Tariff no later than August 31, 2007.
2. Any other party wishing to file a recommendation regarding AmerenUE's Industrial Demand Response Program Tariff, or to respond to Staff's recommendation, shall do so no later than September 10, 2007.
3. This order shall become effective on August 1, 2007.
