**ORDER DENYING RECONSIDERATION**

On November 22, 2011, the Commission issued a notice in which it indicated its intent to take no action to suspend or reject a tariff filed by Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, to implement changes to its residential energy efficiency programs. Subsequently, Ameren Missouri's tariff became effective by operation of law on its November 24 effective date. On December 1, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to reconsider its November 22 notice regarding Ameren Missouri's tariff.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 140-2.160(2) permits the filing of motions for reconsideration of procedural and interlocutory orders. It allows the Commission to reconsider such orders at any time before it issues a final order in the case. In this case, the Commission has issued no order that can be reconsidered. Instead, the Commission simply took no action to suspend or reject a tariff that has since gone into

effect by operation of law. There is nothing to reconsider, and the Commission will deny Public Counsel's motion.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Public Counsel's Motion for Reconsideration is denied.
2. This order shall be effective immediately upon issuance.
