STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), and respectfully states as follows:

1. On January 12, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed with the Commission a tariff sheet seeking to implement, pursuant to KCPL's Experimental Regulatory Plan¹, an online energy program for the Company's non-residential customers. The proposed tariff sheet bears an effective date of February 12, 2006.

2. Attached hereto as Appendix A is the Staff's Memorandum presenting the results of its analysis and recommending Commission approval of the following tariff sheet, to be effective February 12, 2006

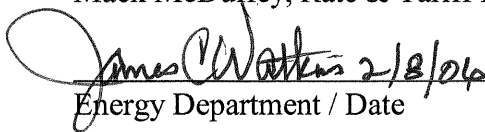

SUBJECT: Staff Recommendation For **Approval** of Tariff Sheet Filed To Implement An Online
Energy Information Program For Non-Residential Customers

DATE: February 8, 2006

On January 12, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL or Company) of Kansas City, Missouri, filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) one (1) tariff sheet titled "Online Energy Information - Schedule OEIC" with a proposed effective date of February 12, 2006 to implement an online energy information program (Program) for non-residential customers . This filing was made pursuant to the agreement by KCPL to file tariffs for each of the Company's demand response, efficiency and affordability Programs proposed to be implemented as a part of its Experimental Regulatory Plan approved by the Commission in its July 28, 2005 Report And Order in Case No. EO-2005-0329. The Program is one of the efficiency programs described in Appendix C of the Stipulation and Agreement. It was reviewed by the Customer Programs Advisory Group (CPAG) established by the Experimental Regulatory Plan, and is similar to the program that went into effect on December 21, 2005 for residential customers (Online Energy Information - Schedule OEI).

The objective of this Program is to allow non-residential customers with computers to access their billing information for purposes of analyzing their usage on a day-to-day, week-to-week, month-to-month or year-to-year basis, and comparing their usage to benchmarking data for similar types of businesses. Customers will also be able to analyze the end uses that make up their total usage, and to access ways to save energy by end use through a searchable resource center. Targeted case studies provide ideas relevant to the customer's industry.

The projected cost of the Company's participation in this Program for each of the next four years is stated below:

2006	\$144,000
2007	\$103,000
2008	\$103,000
2009	\$104,000

Since this is an informational program and measuring potential savings will be difficult, if not impossible, KCPL does not propose to evaluate the program for energy savings; however, KCPL will provide reports on participation to the CPAG.

Any funds remaining after each Program year will be added to the succeeding year's Program. At the termination of the Program, any excess funds will be made available for other efficiency programs.

The Commission's Energy Department Staff (Staff) has reviewed the filed tariff sheet. Because this program does not qualify as a promotional practice, the supporting information required by 4 CSR 240-3.150(3) for Promotional Practices tariff filings is not required for this filing. Staff therefore recommends that the Commission issue an Order approving the following proposed tariff sheet, as filed on January 12, 2006, to become effective on February 12, 2006, as requested in KCPL's cover letter, or permit the tariff sheet to go into effect by operation of law:

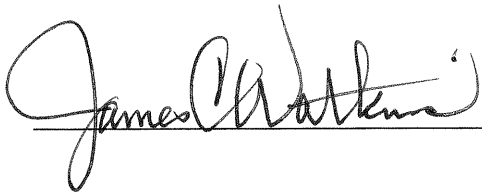

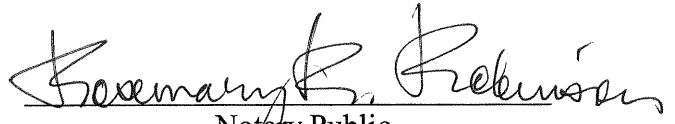
