**ORDER CANCELING REMAINING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND**  
**DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE MEMORANDUM REGARDING**  
**STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT**

In its Report and Order in AmerenUE's most recent rate case, ER-2007-0002, the Commission ordered Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE to file a revised Industrial Demand Response tariff. AmerenUE initially filed a revised tariff on July 2, 2007. That tariff drew opposition from various parties and AmerenUE withdrew it and replaced it with a revised tariff on October 23, 2007. That second tariff again drew opposition, causing the Commission to suspend it until March 21, 2008. Subsequently, the Commission established a procedural schedule leading to a hearing set for February 26 and 27.

On January 25, AmerenUE withdrew its second tariff and replaced it with a third tariff that carries an effective date of February 24. This time, the newly revised tariff was accompanied by a stipulation and agreement indicating that the signatory parties do not oppose this version of the tariff. Given the apparent agreement of the parties, the Commission will cancel the remaining procedural schedule, including the hearing.

The stipulation and agreement provides that the Commission's Staff may submit a memorandum to the Commission explaining its rationale for entering into the stipulation and agreement. Such a memorandum may be helpful to the Commission and the Commission will direct its Staff to file such a memorandum as soon as possible, but no later than February 5.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The remaining procedural schedule, including the hearing set for February 26 and 27, 2008, is cancelled.
2. Staff shall file a memorandum explaining its rationale for entering into the stipulation and agreement as soon as possible, but no later than February 5, 2008.
3. This order shall become effective on January 28, 2008.
