ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

Issue Date: November 16, 2007 Effective Date: November 22, 2007

In its Report and Order in Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's most recent rate case, ER-2007-0002, the Commission ordered AmerenUE to file a revised Industrial Demand Response tariff. AmerenUE initially filed such a tariff on July 2, 2007, with a 90-day effective date of October 1. On September 25, the Commission suspended that initial tariff for 30 days to allow the parties more time to negotiate. On October 23, AmerenUE withdrew its initial tariff and replaced it with a new tariff that bears a November 22 effective date.

Staff filed a recommendation regarding AmerenUE's second tariff on November 15.

Staff recommends the Commission approve the tariff, but indicates other interested parties are still dissatisfied with the tariff. Subsequently, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend the tariff.

Given the continued disagreements, the Commission will suspend the tariff for 120 days, as permitted by Section 393.150, RSMo 2000.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The tariff sheets issued on October 23, 2007, by Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, and assigned Tariff No. YE-2008-0262, are suspended for a period of 120 days beyond November 22, 2007, to March 21, 2008, or until otherwise ordered by this Commission. The tariff sheets suspended are:
