**ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION**

Effective Date: July 31, 2009

On July 23, 2009, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE filed a tariff along with a motion asking the Commission to expedite its approval of that tariff. The "Personal Energy Manager Rebate Pilot" tariff carries an effective date of August 22, but the company asks the Commission to approve the tariff to go into effect on August 6 so that it can be in effect during expected peak usage conditions. On July 24, the Commission ordered its Staff to file a recommendation regarding AmerenUE's tariff no later than July 31. That order also required any other party wishing to file a recommendation to do so no later than July 31.

Staff did not file its recommendation on July 31. Instead, Staff filed a motion indicating it has been unable to complete its recommendation and asking to be allowed until August 3 to file that recommendation.

The Commission will grant Staff's request, but emphasizes that if the Commission is to act on AmerenUE's tariff at its August 5 agenda meeting, it must have Staff's recommendation no later than August 3.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's "Personal Energy Manager Rebate Pilot" tariff no later than August 3, 2009.

2. Any other party may file a recommendation regarding Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's "Personal Energy Manager Rebate Pilot" tariff no later than August 3, 2009.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
