PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE AND OTHER FEDERAL EXECUTIVE AGENCIES

NOW COMES, the Secretary of Defense, through duly authorized counsel, on behalf of the intervenor, United States Department of Defense and other affected Federal Executive Agencies (hereinafter collectively called "FEA"), and respectfully tenders a proposed procedural schedule in accord with the Order of the Commission dated 16 June 2006.

1. The Staff of the Public Service Commission (Complainant) had informally proposed with dates with which FEA, has no known conflicts. FEA is in agreement with that Staff proposal which FEA believes to be as follows:

24 October 2006	Staff files prepared direct testimony and exhibits (the Case-in-Chief);

11 January 2007	Prehearing conference and Staff files any surrebuttal prepared testimony and exhibits.

23 January 2007 All parties file any cross surrebuttal prepared testimony;

09 February 2007 Staff files list of issues and order of issues;

16 February 2007 All parties submit prehearing briefs;

26 February to 09 March 2007 Oral evidentiary hearings to cross examine all witnesses on their prepared testimony

- 3. All parties file simultaneous Initial Briefs and all parties file (any) Reply Briefs in accord with Rules of Practice, 4 CSR 240-2.140(2). FEA has not requested oral argument unless it is granted to other parties. If granted to others, FEA would want to at least have the opportunity to participate in such oral argument. The timing of any oral argument presumably would be in accord with Rules of Practice, 4 CSR 240-2.140(1).
- 4. Again, FEA is in agreement with the Staff's proposed schedule as it understands it as set forth herein.
