**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE**

Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a tariff on March 31, 2021, to increase its rates for natural gas service. Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri (Renew Missouri) applied to intervene on April 30, 2021. More than ten days have passed since Renew Missouri applied to intervene and no party has responded to that application.<sup>1</sup>

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3) provides that the Commission may grant a motion to intervene if it finds that the proposed intervenor has an interest that differs from that of the general public and that may be adversely affected by the final order arising from the case, or if granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. The Commission finds that allowing Renew Missouri to participate in this rate case will serve the public interest. The Commission will grant the application to intervene.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Renew Missouri’s Application to Intervene is granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
