Commissioner Rupp,

In response to your question, based on the sessions that I attended, I would say that overall the companies did not get into the specifics around savings resulting from the analytics work. The focus of the presentations was more about how to use data analytics, the tools that are available, and example use cases where analytics were being explored. As most utilities are in the early stages of developing skills around advanced analytics, it is apparent that many are still creating the analytics and not actually broadly applying them to their processes, so not a lot of financial results are available. In addition, often the analytics are used to reach non-financial performance targets relating to reliability and customer satisfaction, which are even more difficult to predict.
