<u>APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT</u>

Comes now American Fiber Systems, Inc. ("AFS"), and hereby files this Application for Approval of an Interconnection Agreement (the "Agreement") between AFS and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., dba Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT"), under the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Public Law No. 104-104 ("Federal Act"), and 4 C.S.R. 240-2.060, stating the following:

A. PRELIMINARY MATTERS

- 1. AFS is a competitive telecommunications company, certificated by the Commission by order dated November 28, 2000, to provide interexchange and nonswitched local exchange services on a competitive basis. AFS's office and principal place of business is located at 100 Meridien Centre, Suite 250, Rochester, New York 14618-3979, and its telephone number is 585/340-5400. AFS is a Delaware corporation authorized to do business in Missouri. A copy of its Certificate of Good Standing from the Missouri Secretary of State is attached as Exhibit A hereto.

B. INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT REACHED

3. AFS presents to this Commission for approval the Agreement negotiated and executed pursuant to the terms of the Federal Act (Agreement, Exhibit B). After comprehensive, good faith negotiations to address all of the complex issues involved in such an agreement, AFS and SWBT executed the Agreement on October 9, 2002, and October 16, 2002, respectively. The Agreement is SWBT's 13-State Interconnection Agreement. All matters between the parties have been successfully negotiated, and there are no outstanding issues requiring the assistance of mediation or arbitration.

C. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

- 4. AFS seeks the Commission's approval of the Agreement, consistent with the provisions of the Federal Act and Missouri law. AFS believes that the implementation of this Agreement complies fully with Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 because the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. The Agreement promotes diversity in providers, provides interconnectivity, and increases customer choices for telecommunications services.
- 5. AFS respectfully requests that the Commission grant expeditious approval of this Agreement, without change, suspension or other delay in its implementation. This is a bilateral

Agreement, reached as a result of negotiations and compromise between competitors, and intervention by other parties is neither necessary nor appropriate.

D. STANDARD FOR REVIEW

- 6. The statutory standards of review are set forth in Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 which provides as follows:
 - (1) APPROVAL REQUIRED.—Any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State commission. A State commission to which an agreement is submitted shall approve or reject the agreement, with written findings as to any deficiencies.
 - (2) GROUNDS FOR REJECTION.--The State commission may only reject --
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) if it finds that --
 - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
 - (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity; . . .
- 7. AFS does not have any pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment, or decision has occurred within three years of the date of this Application.
 - 8. AFS does not have any annual report or assessments which are overdue.
- 9. The Affidavit attached as Exhibit C establishes that the Agreement submitted herein satisfies these standards.

E. CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, AFS respectfully requests that the Commission approve the attached Interconnection Agreement between SWBT and AFS.
