ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE

On April 22, 2021, Christie R. Hicks filed a motion for leave to appear *pro hac vice* as attorney for the Environmental Defense Fund (EDF) in this case. The Commission granted the EDF's application to intervene on December 30, 2020.

Ms. Hicks states that she is an attorney with EDF. Ms. Hicks is not licensed to practice law in Missouri, but states she is a member in good standing of the State Bar of Illinois. She states that she has never been subject to any order of discipline or disability by any Bar, nor had any request for pro hac vice admission denied or revoked.

Ms. Hicks says she is associated in this matter with Lewis Mills, Missouri Bar No. 35275, who has already entered his appearance on behalf of EDF in this case.

Ms. Hicks has provided proof that she has complied with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m).

The Commission has reviewed the motion and finds it complies with the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.040(3)(C) and Missouri Supreme Court Rule 9.03.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The motion for admission *pro hac vice*, as described above, is granted.
