On October 23, 2007, the Commission ordered the parties to file a progress report regarding their efforts to devise a revised Industrial Demand Response tariff. Subsequently on October 23, AmerenUE withdrew the tariff that the Commission had suspended and filed a substitute tariff that is to become effective on November 22. In light of that action, a progress report is no longer needed and the Commission will relieve the parties of their obligation to file such a report.

1. The parties to this case are relieved of their obligation to file a progress report, as previously ordered by the Commission.
