ORDER APPROVING EXPEDITED TARIFF

Issue Date: November 1, 2007 Effective Date: November 2, 2007

On October 26, 2007, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed a revised tariff that would provide financial assistance to customers who choose to convert their existing overhead service to an underground installation. AmerenUE initially filed this revised tariff on October 2, with a November 2 effective date. However, the company withdrew that tariff to make modifications requested by the Commission's Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel. The tariff carries a November 25 effective date, but AmerenUE filed a motion asking the Commission to approve the modified tariff to become effect on November 2, as originally planned. The motion represents that neither Staff, nor Public Counsel, object to the motion or the tariff.

The Commission's Staff filed an expedited recommendation regarding the proposed tariff on October 31. Staff recommends the Commission grant AmerenUE's request for expedited treatment and approve the tariff, with an effective date of November 2.

Based on the recommendation of its Staff, the Commission will approve the submitted tariff on an expedited basis.
