ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Issue Date: February 3, 2010

Effective Date: February 10, 2010

On January 27, 2010, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE issued a tariff that would revise the company's "Residential Energy Efficiency Multi-Family Income Qualified Program." AmerenUE's tariff carries a February 26 effective date, but along with its tariff, the company filed a motion asking the Commission to approve the tariff to take effect on February 10. AmerenUE explains that the revised tariff will allow the company to pay an incentive directly to the installer of an energy efficiency project rather than paying the incentive to the building owner. In addition, the tariff would require the owner of the building to commit to implement energy efficiency measures in common areas of the building.

The Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation regarding AmerenUE's tariff no later than February 2. The Commission also ordered that any other party wanting to file a recommendation regarding the tariff do so no later than February 2.

The Commission's Staff filed its recommendation regarding AmerenUE's tariff on January 29. Staff explains that the Commission should expedite its approval of

AmerenUE's tariff because early approval of the tariff will benefit the tenants of the buildings in which energy efficient lighting and appliances will be installed.

Based on the recommendation of its Staff, the Commission finds that the tariff submitted by AmerenUE should be approved on less than thirty days' notice.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The proposed electric service tariff sheets submitted under Tariff File No. JE-2010-0475 by Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, are approved, effective on and after February 10, 2010. The specific tariff sheets approved are:
