ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

Issue Date: July 27, 2011

Effective Date: August 10, 2011

On July 11, 2011, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (KCPL-GMO) filed a tariff that would freeze the availability of its solar rebate program. KCPL-GMO's tariff carries a 30-day effective date that would put the tariff in effect on August 10. The Commission's Staff filed a motion on July 20, asking the Commission to reject that tariff. The Commission allowed interested parties until July 25 to respond to Staff's motion. KCPL-GMO filed its response on July 25.

KCPL-GMO seeks to suspend its solar rebate program because the Circuit Court of Cole County has issued an order that declares the solar rebate provisions of Section 393.1030.3 RSMo (Supp. 2010) to be unconstitutional. The Commission is uncertain about the effect of the circuit court's order and will therefore suspend KCPL-GMO's tariff for a period of 120 days as permitted by Section 393.150.1, RSMo 2000.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff submitted under Tariff File No. JE-2012-0015, on July 11, 2011, by KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company is suspended from August 10, 2011, to December 8, 2011.
