ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO AMEND RESPONSE

This case was established to consider revisions to Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's Industrial Demand Response Tariff. On July 12, 2007, the Missouri Energy Group (MEG) filed a pleading entitled *Response of Missouri Energy Group to AmerenUE's Response to Commission Order Respecting AmerenUE's Revised Industrial Demand Response Program Tariff*. Four days later, on July 16, MEG filed a pleading seeking leave to amend its previous pleading to correct a factual error, as well as, a typographical error. More than ten days have passed since the motion for leave to amend was filed and no party has objected to it.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(20) provides: "Any pleading may be amended within ten (10) days of filing, unless a responsive pleading has already been filed, or at any time by leave of the commission." No party has filed a response to the pleading that MEG seeks to amend, so MEG can amend that pleading without leave of the Commission. However, since MEG has requested leave, the Commission will grant that request.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Missouri Energy Group is granted leave to amend its pleading entitled *Response of Missouri Energy Group to AmerenUE's Response to Commission Order Respecting AmerenUE's Revised Industrial Demand Response Program Tariff*.
2. This order shall become effective on July 27, 2007.
