ORDER SUSPENDING AMERENUE'S OBLIGATION TO FILE
DIRECT TESTIMONY

The procedural schedule for this case requires Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE to file direct testimony supporting its challenged Industrial Demand Response tariff by December 21, 2007. On December 21, AmerenUE filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend that requirement of the procedural schedule.

AmerenUE indicates the parties have reached a verbal agreement on the design of a new Industrial Demand Response tariff. As part of that agreement, AmerenUE will withdraw the currently suspended tariff and replace it with a new tariff, which it intends to file by January 11, 2008.

If the revised Industrial Demand Response tariff is acceptable to the other parties and to the Commission, there will be no need for a hearing. Therefore, the Commission will suspend the procedural schedule to relieve AmerenUE of the obligation to file direct testimony on December 21. Instead, the Commission will order AmerenUE to file either a revised tariff or its direct testimony by January 11. The rest of the procedural schedule,

including the hearing set for February 26 and 27, shall remain in effect until further order of the Commission.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE is relieved of the obligation to file its direct testimony by December 21, 2007.
2. Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE shall file either a revised Industrial Demand Response tariff, or its direct testimony supporting its current tariff, no later than January 11, 2008.
3. This order shall become effective on December 21, 2007.
