ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

On January 27, 2010, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE filed a tariff along with a motion asking the Commission to expedite its approval of that tariff. The "Residential Energy Efficiency Multi-Family Income Qualified Program" tariff carries an effective date of February 26, but the company asks the Commission to approve the tariff to go into effect on February 10.

Before acting on AmerenUE's tariff, the Commission will require a recommendation from its Staff. The Commission will also establish a deadline for any other party who wishes to file a recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's "Residential Energy Efficiency Multi-Family Income Qualified Program" tariff no later than February 2, 2010.
2. Any other party that wants to file a recommendation regarding Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's "Residential Energy Efficiency Multi-Family Income Qualified Program" tariff shall do so no later than February 2, 2010.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
