## **ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE EXPEDITED RECOMMENDATION AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR OTHER PARTIES TO OFFER RECOMMENDATIONS**

On July 15, 2011, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a tariff that would suspend its Rider SR – Solar Rebate tariff. Ameren Missouri's tariff carries a 30-day effective date that would put the tariff in effect on August 14. However, Ameren Missouri filed a motion along with its tariff asking the Commission to expedited its consideration of the compliance tariff and to approve the tariff to go into effect on July 22, or as soon thereafter as possible.

It will not be possible for the Commission to act by July 22, but the Commission will order its Staff to file an expedited recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's tariff, and will establish a date by which other interested parties may file a recommendation regarding that tariff.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Staff shall file its recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's tariff to suspend its Rider SR – Solar Rebate tariff, Tariff No. YE-2011-0020, no later than July 25, 2011.

2. Any other party wishing to file a recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's tariff to suspend its Rider SR – Solar Rebate tariff, Tariff No. YE-2011-0020, shall do so no later than July 25, 2011.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
