## ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company, filed an application for an Accounting Authority Order. The Staff of the Commission recommends that the Commission reject MGE's request. It is expected that the prehearing conference will provide an opportunity for the parties to further pursue settlement discussions.
