On May 18, 2020, Spire Missouri Inc. (Spire Missouri) applied for an accounting authority order to govern costs and financial impacts associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. Spire Missouri also requests waiver of the Commission's 60-day notice requirement under 20 CSR 4240-4.017.

The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention applications.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's data center shall provide notice of this order and Spire Missouri's application to the parties in File Nos. GR-2017-0215 and GR-2017-0216.
2. The Commission's data center shall provide notice of this order and Spire Missouri's application to the county commissions in Spire Missouri's service territory.
3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of this application to members of the General Assembly representing residents in Spire Missouri's service territory.

4. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of Spire Missouri's application to news media serving residents of Spire Missouri's service territory.

5. Applications for intervention shall be filed no later than June 8, 2020. Any such filing shall be submitted through the Commission's electronic filing and information system or delivered to:
