**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DEADLINE FOR  
INTERVENTION APPLICATIONS**

On October 16, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri applied for an accounting authority order permitting it to track and defer in regulatory assets all incremental costs and other financial impacts including lost revenues related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Ameren Missouri also requests a waiver of the Commission’s 60-day notice requirement of 20 CSR 4240-4.017.

The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention applications.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission’s data center shall provide notice of this order and Ameren Missouri’s application to the parties in File No. GR-2019-0077.
2. The Commission’s Data Center shall provide notice of this order and application to the county commissions in the service territory of Ameren Missouri.
3. The Commission’s Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of this application to members of the General Assembly representing residents in the service territory of Ameren Missouri.

4. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of Ameren Missouri's application to news media serving residents of the service territory of Ameren Missouri.

5. Applications for intervention shall be filed no later than November 10, 2020. Any such filing shall be submitted through the Commission's electronic filing and information system or delivered to:
