WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), and
for its *Withdrawal of Motion* respectfully states:

1. On June 23, 2020, Staff filed a *Motion to Invite Comments Regarding Costs of Compliance* in this docket, in order to aid its review per Section 536.200.3, RSMo.
2. That same day, the Commission granted Staff's motion.
3. However, Section 536.200.3, RSMo, requires a review "at the end of the first full fiscal year after the implementation of the rule, amendment, or rescission...."
4. The effective date of the rule was July 30, 2019, within the 2020 fiscal year,¹ and a review at this time would be premature because there has not been a "first full fiscal year after the implementation of the rule, amendment, or rescission" by which to determine the cost to all affected entities as required by Section 536.200.3.

WHEREFORE, Staff prays that the Commission will accept its
Withdrawal of Motion.
