ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

This case was established to consider revisions to Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's Industrial Demand Response Tariff. The Missouri Energy Group (MEG)¹ filed an application to intervene on July 9, 2007. More than ten days have passed since the application to intervene was filed and no party has objected to it.

The Commission finds that MEG has an interest that is different from that of the general public and that its interest may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing MEG to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of the Missouri Energy Group, is granted.
