## ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

Issue Date: July 27, 2011 Effective Date: August 14, 2011

On July 15, 2011, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a tariff that would suspend its Rider SR – Solar Rebate tariff. Ameren Missouri's tariff carries a 30-day effective date that would put the tariff in effect on August 14. However, Ameren Missouri filed a motion along with its tariff asking the Commission to expedite its consideration of the tariff and to approve the tariff to go into effect on July 22, or as soon thereafter as possible.

The Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation and allowed other interested parties until July 25 to offer their own recommendations. Staff filed its recommendation on July 20, advising the Commission to reject Ameren Missouri's tariff.

Ameren Missouri seeks to suspend its solar rebate rider because the Circuit Court of Cole County has issued an order that declares the solar rebate provisions of Section 393.1030.3 RSMo (Supp. 2010) to be unconstitutional. The Commission is uncertain about the effect of the circuit court's order and will therefore suspend Ameren Missouri's tariff for a period of 120 days as permitted by Section 393.150.1, RSMo 2000.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The tariff submitted under Tariff File No. YE-2012-0020, on July 15, 2011, by Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, is suspended from August 14, 2011, to December 12, 2011.
