# Title 4 – DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT Division 240 – Public Service Commission Chapter 40 – Gas Utilities and Gas Safety Standards

#### ORDER OF RULEMAKING

By the authority vested in the Public Service Commission under sections 386.250 RSMo 2000, the commission amends a rule as follows:

#### 4 CSR 240-40.020 is amended.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed amendments was published in the *Missouri Register* on November 15, 2007 (32 MoReg 2219). No changes have been made to the proposed amendments, so they are not reprinted here. These proposed amendments become effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: A public hearing on the proposed amendments was held December 17, 2007, and the public comment period ended December 17, 2007. No written comments were received and one (1) person testified at the hearing. The person testifying at the hearing was John Kottwitz on behalf of the staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission. The testimony verified the need for the proposed amendments and generally supported them.

RESPONSE: No changes have been made as a result of these comments.
