The Missouri Public Service Commission is giving notice of the commencement of a contested case and appointment of an arbitrator.

On August 27, 2010, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed the petition. The Commission's regulations provide the right to an evidentiary hearing¹ before the Commission decides the merits of the petition, which signifies that this action is a "contested case."² A contested case is a formal hearing procedure, but it allows for waiver of procedural formalities,³ decision without a hearing,⁴ or voluntary dismissal upon settlement.⁵ The Commission's regulations also provide for discovery.⁶ Any response to the petition is due on September 21, 2010.⁷
