ORDER DIRECTING PARTIES TO FILE PROGRESS REPORT

In its Report and Order in AmerenUE's most recent rate case, ER-2007-0002, the Commission ordered Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE to file a revised Industrial Demand Response tariff. AmerenUE filed its revised tariff on July 2, 2007, with a 90-day effective date of October 1. In a progress report filed on September 19, the parties advised the Commission that they were negotiating toward an agreement on a revised tariff that would satisfy the concerns of all the parties. At the request of the parties, the Commission suspended AmerenUE's tariff until November 1 to allow the parties more time to negotiate.

The November 1 suspension date of the tariff is fast approaching and the parties have not yet advised the Commission of any agreement regarding the tariff. So that it can determine how to proceed, the Commission will order the parties to promptly file another progress report.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The parties to this case shall file a progress report no later than October 26,
 2007, explaining their progress in negotiating the terms of a revised Industrial Demand
 Response Program Tariff.

2. This order shall become effective on October 23, 2007.
