ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

This case was established to consider revisions to Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's Industrial Demand Response Tariff. Noranda Aluminum, Inc., filed an application to intervene on June 26, 2007. More than ten days have passed since the application to intervene was filed and no party has objected to it.

The Commission finds that Noranda has an interest that is different than that of the general public and that its interest may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing Noranda to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of Noranda Aluminum, Inc., is granted.
