**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR CHANGE IN EVALUATION
SCHEDULE**

On April 26, 2012, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a motion asking the Commission to change the evaluation schedule established for its low income weatherization program in the company's last rate case, File Number ER-2011-0028. The order in that case required Ameren Missouri to contract with an independent third party to conduct a process and impact evaluation of the program. It further required the third party to complete its first evaluation by April 30, 2012. Ameren Missouri has engaged the services of a third party to evaluate the program, but, because of problems in obtaining the necessary data, the third party evaluator has not been able to complete its evaluation.

Ameren Missouri asks that the evaluation schedule be changed to extend the due date for completion of the evaluation until July 31, 2012. The motion represents that the interested parties, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the Office of the Public Counsel, and the Commission's Staff, agree that the due date should be extended. The Commission finds that Ameren Missouri's request for extension is reasonable and will grant that motion.

Ameren Missouri filed a revised tariff along with its motion. The tariff revision modifies the terms and conditions of the weatherization program to reflect the extended completion date for the evaluation. The Commission will not take any action regarding that tariff at this time, meaning it will go into effect by operation of law on its proposed effective date of May 26, 2012.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ameren Missouri's Request for Change in Evaluation Schedule for its Low Income Weatherization Program is granted.
2. The due date for the first evaluation of Ameren Missouri's Low Income Weatherization Program is extended from April 30, 2012, until July 31, 2012.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
