## ORDER ESTABLISHING INVESTIGATIVE CASE AND DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE AN INITIAL REPORT

The Commission is concerned about the service and billing issues recently revealed by public complaints regarding Laclede Gas Company's estimated billing practices. The Commission would like to investigate the extent of these problems and whether they extend to other utilities. To that end, the Commission will establish this case.

To start the investigation, the Commission will direct its Staff to file an initial report setting out Staff's recommendations concerning the scope and nature of the investigation. As part of that initial report, Staff shall offer its recommendations on how the public and the affected utilities should be notified of this investigation.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. No later than September 26, 2006, the Commission's Staff shall file an initial report setting out Staff's recommendations concerning the scope and nature of the Commission's investigation into the service and billing practices of Missouri's electric, gas and water utilities.

2. This order shall become effective on September 14, 2006.
