Any request for expedited hearing transcripts must be made before the procedural schedule is established.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of each county within Ameren Missouri's service area.

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Ameren Missouri's service area and to the news media serving therein.

3. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than April 30, 2021, with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission or in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System.

4. Any party wishing to respond to Ameren Missouri's proposed test year shall do so no later than May 6, 2021.

5. No later than May 13, 2021, the parties shall submit a joint proposed procedural schedule as described in this order. The Staff of the Commission shall coordinate and file the joint proposed procedural schedule.

6. This order shall be effective when issued.
