CORRECTED STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE TARIFF SHEET

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through the undersigned counsel, and respectfully states as follows:

1. Staff filed its recommendation in this matter on June 30, 2022. Since then, it has come to Staff's attention that the Staff recommendation memorandum filed on June 30, 2022, contains a few errors which need to be corrected. More specifically, the table at the top of page 4 and the following paragraph need to be corrected as shown below; corrections are shown in bold type:

The proposed change will decrease residential customers' DSIM Rider rate from \$0.00679 to \$0.00478 per kWh.¹ For a residential customer using 1,000 kWh, this would result in a decrease of \$2.01 per month. For a non-residential customer using 1,000 kWh, the new rates would result

in a \$0.34 increase for Small General Service, a \$1.79 decrease for Medium General Service, \$1.39 decrease for Large General Service, and a \$1.61 **decrease** for Large Power Service per month.

2. The foregoing corrections do not affect Staff's ultimate recommendation to approve the proposed tariff sheet. Staff's recommendation to approve this Sixth Revised Sheet No. 49Y does not constitute a review of the prudency of Evergy Metro's actions in relation to its DSIM.

WHEREFORE, Staff requests the Commission accept the above corrections to its Staff recommendation, and recommends the Commission issue an order approving the following proposed tariff sheet, to become effective on August 1, 2022, as requested by Evergy Metro, subject to both true-up and prudence reviews.
