ORDER SETTING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARINGS

Issue Date: November 17, 2022 Effective Date: November 17, 2022

On August 1, 2022,¹ Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed tariff sheets designed to implement a general rate increase for its electric services. On September 28, the Commission issued an order setting a procedural schedule, including an evidentiary hearing in this matter, but did not set out a detailed schedule for local public hearings.

On October 7, Public Counsel submitted proposed language to be included in the notice of local public hearings to be sent to Ameren Missouri's customers. No other party opposed that proposed language. On October 11 and 12, various parties filed proposed locations for a mix of virtual and in-person local public hearings.

The Commission will now set the local public hearings, and will direct Ameren Missouri to provide notice of the local public hearings to their customers.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make an informal presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the

beginning of each local public hearing. Comments to the Commission from the public will begin at the conclusion of the question and answer session.

- 2. Ameren Missouri, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer sessions. Any other party may also choose to have a representative present.
- 3. No later than ten days before the local public hearings, Ameren Missouri shall provide notice of the hearings to each of its customers. Such notice shall use the following language:

NOTICE OF LOCAL PUBLIC HEARINGS ON AMEREN MISSOURI'S ELECTRIC RATES

On August 1, 2022, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a general rate request with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") designed to increase Ameren Missouri's annual gross revenues (exclusive of applicable gross receipts, sales, franchise or occupational fees or taxes) from its Missouri electric retail customers by about \$316 million, or approximately 11.61%. About \$40.76 million of that annual increase is due to increases in Ameren Missouri's fuel and purchased power costs. Ameren Missouri is requesting to rebase and continue its Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC") with modifications. Ameren Missouri is proposing to increase its fixed residential customer charge from \$9.00 per month to the following:

While the amount will vary by residential rate plan and usage pattern, Ameren Missouri is proposing to increase the monthly bill of a residential customer using about 1,017 kilowatt-hours of electricity by approximately \$12.28, or 11.64%. Ameren Missouri estimates that, on average, its proposed rate increase will have the following annual customer bill impacts:

If the Commission approves Ameren Missouri's request to continue its FAC, Ameren Missouri will continue to adjust (credit or bill) the "Fuel Charge" on its electric customers' bills three times each year, on February 1st, June 1st, and October 1st, based on each customer's electrical usage and the difference between Ameren Missouri's actual energy cost (i.e., the varying costs of fuel used to generate electricity at its generating units plus electric energy it purchases on behalf of its customers) and its base energy cost during each four-month accumulation period. For a residential customer using 1,017 kilowatt-hours of electricity a month, Ameren Missouri estimates that the impact of rebasing energy costs in its FAC equates to an increase in such a customer's usage charges of \$1.58 per month.

The Commission will host question-and-answer sessions for the public followed by local public hearings at the following locations and times (live unless designated virtual where public participation is by WebEx video or by telephone).

If you are not a party to this case, you may testify or offer other evidence to the Commission during a local public hearing. Anyone may attend the informal question and answer sessions and the local public hearings; however, the Commission may limit members of the public from testifying or presenting evidence at more than one local public hearing.
