STATEMENT IN OPPOSITION TO MOTION TO INTERVENE

Comes now Union Electric Company ("Applicant") and moves the Commission to deny University City, Missouri, a municipal corporation of the State of Missouri ("University City") Motion to Intervene and as grounds therefor states as follows:

1. On July 24, 1980 the Commission issued an order setting August 22, 1980 as the deadline to intervene in Case No. ER-80-190;

2. A copy of the Commission Order dated July 24, 1980 was sent by the Commission to Mayor Joseph W. Mooney, Mayor of University City, 6801 Delmar, University City, Missouri 63130;

3. University City did not file a motion to intervene until September 16, 1980 which was twenty-five (25) days after said deadline set by the Commission;

4. Motion filed by University City was not received by Applicant until September 22, 1980, as it was sent to Francis X. Duda, Esquire, of Schlafly, Griesedieck, Ferrell and Toft, Attorneys at Law, who was never employed to represent Applicant in this case, and it was not sent to Stewart W. Smith, Jr. as was required by Commission Order dated July 24, 1980;

5. Motion filed by University City did not state why said motion was not timely filed or should be allowed to be filed past the deadline established by the Commission;

6. Motion further did not state good cause shown pursuant to late filed intervention regulation 4 CSR 240-2.110 (14) in that:

- A. University City through its Mayor, City Manager, and various Council members, did in fact have the opportunity and did testify before the Commission at the St. Louis public hearing held on September 16, 1980 at 7:00 p.m. in the St. Louis County Council Chambers;
- B. The Commission did in fact notify University City on July 24, 1980 and said City failed to intervene within the deadline set by the Commission in its Order of that date;

7. Motion did not comply with the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.080 (2) in that:

- A. University City failed to properly serve Applicant with a copy of its Motion as is required by the above-named regulation and the Commission's Order dated July 24, 1980;

8. Motion improperly states that: ". . . A COPY OF THE FOREGOING WAS MAILED TO ALL ATTORNEYS OF RECORD OF ALL PARTIES AT THEIR BUSINESS ADDRESSES . . .";

9. Upon learning of this Motion by indirect means, Applicant now files this Statement.

WHEREFORE, because of the foregoing, Applicant moves that the Commission deny University City, Missouri's Motion to Intervene.
