In the matter of Union Electric Company
of St. Louis, Missouri, for authority
to file revised tariffs for incandescent
lighting service provided to customers
in the Missouri service area of the
company.

ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR RESETTING

On September 29, 1980, Intervenor, the City of University City,
Missouri, and James Carl, an individual, jointly filed with this Commission a
"Motion for Resetting" requesting that the above-styled case be continued to
Monday, October 20, 1980, or to another date during that week or the week of
October 6, 1980, on a day mutually available and agreeable to counsel and to
the Commission.

In support of the requested continuance the motion states, inter alia,
that one of Intervenor's counsel has been retained in this case very recently and
has a case set for rehearing argument in the Court of Appeals, Western District,
on October 2, 1980, the presently scheduled hearing date in this matter.
Additionally, the motion states that certain of Intervenor's witnesses will not
be able to be present or prepared on the date presently scheduled for hearing
in this matter, and that without a resetting, Intervenor will not be able to
prepare proper motions in order to obtain certain information necessary to their
cases. The motion further states that counsel for Union Electric Company has
been informed of Intervenor's intention to request a resetting and that the
Company has no objection to same.

The Commission has considered the "Motion for Resetting" filed by
the above-named Intervenor in this matter and concludes that the same is
reasonable and should be granted. In light of the Commission's present docket
schedule, the above-styled case shall be continued to Tuesday, October 21, 1980.

The Commission notes that the operation of law date in this matter
occurs in late November, 1980. Therefore, the schedule of proceedings as
revised herein does not permit a sufficient amount of time for the filing of

briefs. Thus, the Commission concludes that the parties should be put on notice that, in lieu of the filing of briefs, the parties will be provided the opportunity, if requested, to present oral argument in this matter immediately following the conclusion of the presentation of evidence.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That Case No. RR-80-190 be, and is, hereby continued from its presently scheduled hearing date of October 2, 1980, to Tuesday, October 21, 1980, at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission's hearing room on the tenth floor of the Jefferson State Office Building, Jefferson City, Missouri.

ORDERED: 2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
