ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Issue Date: January 14, 2015

Effective Date: February 13, 2015

Barbara Ellis filed a complaint alleging that Laclede Gas Company improperly held her responsible for someone else's charges. Laclede responded to the complaint, informing the Commission that all disputed charges billed to Complainant have been removed from her account. Subsequently, the Staff of the Commission filed its Recommendation and also informed the Commission that the disputed charges were removed from Complainant's account.

On December 9, 2014, the Commission issued an order directing Complainant to file a statement, no later than December 20, informing the Commission whether she wished to dismiss this complaint or proceed toward an evidentiary hearing. In its order, the Commission informed Complainant that failure to respond to the Commission's order may result in dismissal of the complaint. Complainant did not respond to the Commission's order.

Under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(3), this complaint will be dismissed for Complainant's failure to respond to the Commission's order. In dismissing this complaint, the Commission makes no determination on the merits thereof.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. This complaint is dismissed.
2. This order shall become effective on February 13, 2015.
3. This file shall be closed on February 14, 2015.
