## ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On April 17, 2008, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE filed a motion asking the Commission to reconsider its order that scheduled a prehearing conference for May 27 and scheduled hearing dates for November 2008. AmerenUE asks that the prehearing conference be moved up to May 12 and the hearing be moved back to December.

The Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties 10 days to respond to a pleading unless a different response time is ordered by the Commission. For this motion, responses would be due by April 28. Since AmerenUE is asking that the prehearing be moved up to May 12, the Commission will shorten the time allowed for responses to allow the Commission enough time to reschedule the prehearing conference if it finds it appropriate to do so.
